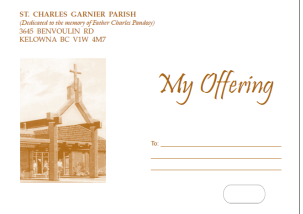
2014 OFFERING ENVELOPES

Your envelope number **changes each year**. Using envelopes from other than the current year could result in confusion and not receiving proper tax credit for your donations.



PRE-AUTHORIZED GIVING PLAN

Stewardship: (Pre) Authorized Giving Plan allows parishioners to make their regular Sunday offering using the “direct debit” system. SAG is an option, not a requirement! It is being widely used in other dioceses, and the diocese wants to make it available to those parishioners who would like to take advantage of it. There is a brochure which includes an authorization form enclosed with each set of 2014 envelopes. Brochures are also available on the ledge in the foyer.

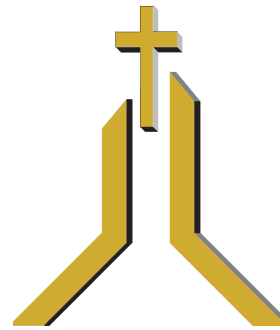
