



PASTOR'S MESSAGE

John the Baptist's name is synonymous with the season of Advent. His cry to repent and to undergo baptism for the forgiveness of sins rings loudly in our ears. But what about those who have already been baptized, many years ago, how do we heed his cry and make straight the way of the Lord?

St. Augustine was the first to speak extensively on the second baptism that is available in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It is as if we re-enter the font and allow the grace we received at Baptism to flow once more. For just as we are led by the Spirit to the waters of new birth, so the Spirit leads us back into the Father's loving embrace in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

In my own life, and in the lives of others, I see how the Spirit breaks down the barriers of resistance to the Lord's presence in the Sacrament. Left to our own devices, most of us would not venture near. But, by his prompting, and by our deepest need to be forgiven, we come and place ourselves in his presence, and we are washed clean.

In addition to individual times of Reconciliation available half and hour before each Mass, our parish will be celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesday, December 11th at 6:30 p.m. Those who are not able to make it are encouraged to go to Corpus Christi Reconciliation Service on Wednesday, December 12th at 6:30 p.m., Immaculate Conception Church Reconciliation on Thursday, December 13th @ 3:30 p.m., Our Lady of Lourdes Reconciliation Service on Wednesday, December 19th at 6:30 p.m. or St. Pius X Reconciliation Service on Thursday, December 20th @ 6:30 p.m.






Our parish needs additional Sacristans. It's a "behind-the-scenes" ministry allowing for quiet service in the church, the duties are a devotional joy!

- **Advent**
This Sunday the first candle (purple) is lit.
- **Include a prayer intention**
A conversation with God can place everything that follows with all that God wants to do for us and with us. We share from our own concerns, but we want to be sure to listen to God's compassionate response. May it be a time of special grace.
- **Speak with others**
Include faith in the conversation, joining with one, two or three others (or your whole family) first, then expand the conversation more broadly. Be open to their thoughts without needing to correct or convince. Really get to understand exactly what they are saying. There will be more time to react and clarify as time goes on.
- **Share your experience** – check out the online resources here
