## CCCB STATEMENT ON LEGALIZATION OF CANNABIS

On 19 June 2018, the Senate passed Bill C-45, the Cannabis Act. On 21 June 2018, the Bill received Royal Assent, thereby legalizing marijuana for recreational use in Canada. In response, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) is issuing a "Statement on the Legalization of Cannabis/Marijuana for Recreational Use."
