Our Parish Pastoral Council is rejuvenating itself slowly. We are presently looking for one or two members to come on board. CCCB STATEMENT ON LEGALIZATION OF CANNABIS

On 19 June 2018, the Senate passed Bill C-45, the Cannabis Act. On 21 June 2018, the Bill received Royal Assent, thereby legalizing marijuana for recreational use in Canada.
