PASTOR'S MESSAGE

We continue to rejoice with the Khan family and their safe arrival to Canada from Pakistan via Thailand. The two brothers with their wives and five children, together with their sister and mother are housed in a six bedroom home. They show a great eagerness to integrate into our culture and have taken the first steps in finding work. Please introduce yourself to them over the coming weeks, and please continue to support our Committee that is helping them get settled.

Some of you have been asking regarding the bike ride up to the Pen-nask Summit. How did it go? Did anyone ride with you? It went better than expected, with one minor glitch. I really didn't know where the actual summit was, thinking it was much further up the road. As a consequence, I missed the sign and kept biking until I reached the Elkhart Brake Check and the first significant descent on the other side. I knew by then that I had gone too far (by about 15 to 20 km). On my way back, I did see the sign and had a good laugh.

I did have a fellow peddler; he was a little bit behind me. We had stopped at about the halfway point and assessed how we were doing. We were both having a very good climb. When he reached the summit, he didn't realize I had continued past the summit in error. This caused him some worry (as later I would be worried about him too—realizing he was no longer behind me). When I got home, a message was waiting on my answering machine and e-mail. Michael, my fellow peddler, was hoping to hear from me, to find out what happened. We were both happy that we got home safe.

So far we've raised a little over \$18,000 for the support we are offering the Khan family in their resettlement. We continue to urge those who may not have made a pledge to do so in the next few weeks. At this time, I would like to thank everyone for their contributions and support in giving us a strong financial foundation on which to build.


