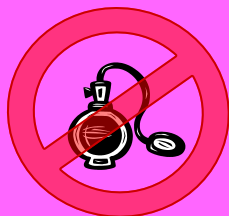

THE NATIVITY

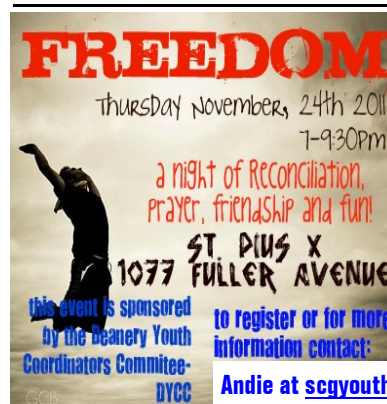

For by believing they are hewn out, as it were, from mountains and forests, like stones and timber; but by baptism and instruction they are, as it were, shaped, squared and planed by the hands of the workers and artisans. Nevertheless, they do not make a house for the Lord until they are fitted together through love"

(St. Augustine, Sermon 36).

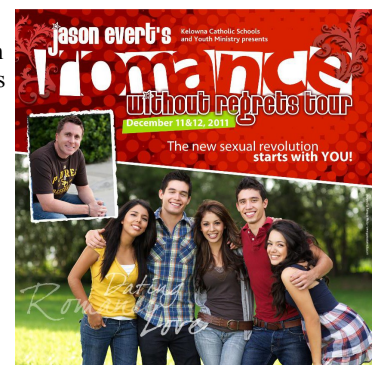
The primary idea behind the changes taking place in the liturgy is the unity that we enjoy with Christ, a unity that is meant to be lived out in our communion with each other - which is why it is so important that we all are willing to embrace the changes and to act collectively. The liturgy, which means The Work of the People, is not a time for private prayer or devotion. We are to make time for that during the week, at which time we are free to express our piety as the Spirit moves us.

I think that we are doing pretty good with the changes so far. There will be changes in language; in the Creed, the I Confess, as well as some other bits and pieces. The Sunday missals for this year have all of the changes in them and I encourage every household to take a missal home with you next weekend. Bring them to church with you if you like, but more importantly, read the prayers and readings sometime during the week and let the Holy Spirit open them for you. You will be surprised what the mass has to offer you if you take even a few minutes to prepare your minds and hearts for it.

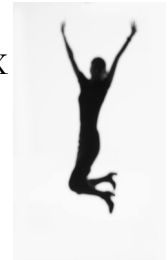
