

I am encouraged by the number of people who have approached me to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. I would like to do all that is possible to promote this Sacrament and its regular availability to those who seek to hear God's words of forgiveness and healing.

Starting this week, I will be in the confessional between 8 am and 8:20 am before each weekday Mass. I will also be in the confessional from 4:15—4:45 pm on Saturday evening, from 7:45—8:15 am and from 10:00-10:15 am on Sunday morning and from 6:15-6:45 pm on Sunday evening. Please come early on those days you would like to go to confession.

In order to give some extra time to the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, I will curtail my duties as doorkeeper until fifteen minutes before Mass. This will give me an opportunity to clear my head prior to the Mass and to enjoy the fresh air my body so much enjoys. It is my prayer that more of you will take advantage of these posted times for confessions and that our sense of Grace and mercy redoubles in our parish.

I will continue to be available for appointments outside of these times. This will be done by request.


