#### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

At our latest Usher's workshop, we reviewed our emergency procedures. In the case of a medical emergency the ushers will be responsible for attending to the person, finding a nurse, doctor or first aid person to assist, phoning 911 and waiting outside for the ambulance. Much of this has already been happening and we ask for the assistance of those with medical training to continue to offer their assistance in these instances. Clear instruction regarding street address are at each of our phones (Kitchen and Sacristy). We are also looking into purchasing an AED machine for those who may have had a heart attack, In the case of a medical emergency the Mass will continue as usual with the possible exception of not using the aisle at communion time if it hinders the first aid attenders. The most important thing for everyone to do is keep the person in your prayers.

In the case of a fire or other emergency, please keep in mind that there are many exit points. Please take a moment to become aware of the many ways you can exit the building. The ushers will be there to assist. Please also be aware that it is crucial for us to muster on the lawn near Mary's Grotto. This is to ensure that everyone has actually left the building. It is crucial, therefore, that you do not hop in your cars and drive away. We will be asking everyone to take a quick look around to make sure that their nearest pew mates are accounted for. For the safety of all concerned, and to make sure no one needs rescuing, please don't forget to muster on the lawn near Mary's Grotto. Thank you.







#### **BEGINNING A CONVERSATION**

#### ~ Part 2 ~

The overall theme for First Nations Ministry is Respecting the Sacred. The themes for Advent will be as follows: for the first Sunday of Advent – Sacred Name, the second Sunday of Advent – Sacred Place, and the third Sunday of Advent – Sacred Time. Since the fourth week is a really short one, there are no sessions planned.

Next week the conversation will begin and suggestions will be given for each week.

Currently in our diocese, there is one First Nations Church that celebrates Mass weekly, several that have Mass monthly, one that has Mass three times a year, one twice a year, and several that have not celebrated Mass in many, many years.

This will also be the first time in our diocese that an invitation has been extended to our diocesan Catholic Schools. The BC Ministry of Education has developed a new First Nations Principles which is embedded into the curriculum and is part of the learning program in our Catholic schools. For the First Nations students attending our schools, these young members of our Catholic family will be a part of a broader conversation for a long time. We pray for healing and understanding as we all seek unity.

Many communities have very active Métis groups and we want to reach out and include them too. The richness that is ours: being served by Priests from the Philippines, India, Africa, Ireland, and North America. We are truly blessed to have this cultural diversity.

New announcements will continue until Sunday, December 16th (the Third Sunday of Advent). Each announcement will suggest a specific conversation. After your time with others there are a number of possible ways to share the results with me:
