With the Feasts of All Saints, All Souls and Remembrance Day, November is set aside as a time to remember the deceased members of our community and an opportunity to reflect on our ultimate purpose in life. To mark the occasion, we encourage you to write the names of your deceased in our parish's Book of Remembrance beginning on November 1st.

In order to facilitate Mass attendance on this feast day, there will be an extra Mass at 6:15 pm. Those who want to stay for the workshop, "How to Pray with the Bible", beginning at 7:00 pm, are encouraged to do so.

There will also be a short prayer service, to mark All Souls Day at 3:00 pm on November 2nd. This will give those who traditionally visit the graves of their loved ones to do so, returning to the church for prayer, support and a snack. Those who are able to bring a snack to share are encouraged to do so.

Beginning on November 1st we will also provide small vigil candles for sale. These are left over from our transition to the new electric vigil lights. We are encouraging people to make a small donation to our Refugee Fund and using the vigil lights at the gravesite of your loved ones or as a remembrance of them in your homes during the month of November.




