Partners on the Road to Freedom

Throughout the dark days of the 24-year Indonesian occupation of Timor-Leste, the Catholic Church was an important defender of the Timorese peoples human rights. Bishop Carlos Ximenes Belo, with the help of DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and other Catholic agencies worldwide, brought the worlds attention to the human rights abuses the Timorese people were suffering. In 1999, Indonesia withdrew from the country. In 2002, Timor-Leste became a nation.

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE has worked in solidarity with the Timorese Church's agencies such as the *Justice and Peace Commission* and *Radio Kmanek* since the early 1990s. In recent years we have also accompanied women's organizations as they work on issues that primarily affect women and children, including domestic violence. All of our Timorese partners are journeying on the long road to building what Bishop Belo calls 'compassionate democracy'.

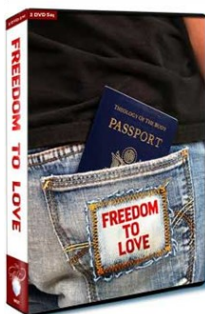
Freedom is a Powerful Word

GUARDIANS OF GOD'S CREATION

LENT 2011 - WEEK 5

Just as Jesus grieved over the death of Lazarus, so our Lord Creator must be grieving over the devastation forced on all His creation. In the gospel readings for this 5th Sunday of Lent, the words of Jesus, **"Unbind him, and let him go"** (John 11:44) may resound in the hearts of his servants and guardians of His creation as a call to free creation from the bondage of exploitation and destruction. And, it is up to the new prophets of hope to raise awareness to the damage that major industries driven by **GREED - the drive for Power and Material WEALTH**, are forcing on basic natural resources like water. These cause great environmental damage that bring many chronic and fatal health risks to the human family, and the destruction—to the point of extinction, of many of the creatures that share this earth with us.

In Guatemala, a Canadian mining giant along with the Guatemalan government are ignoring evidence showing toxic waste from the mine is poisoning the local water supply essential to agricultural development and posing great health risks especially for children.

In order to **"Unbind him, and let him go"**, we must first unbind our hearts to doubt and fear, and that discomfort arising from stepping out of our comfort zone. But, our hearts and eyes need to be wide open to the human and ecological suffering all around the world. God is calling us to protect and care for His creation in all its manifestations. He will empower us to that end, but we must open our eyes and hearts to that call. Right now, no matter what our situation or location, we can learn about the incredible struggles that God's creation is facing. Let us pray that God may open our eyes and our hearts to righteous action, and be faithful to "not grow weary in doing good," (2 Thess 3:13) whatever form it may take.

It is in this spirit of **"unbinding"** our hearts and eyes, hands and feet that we invite you to join us on **Apr 15 @ 7pm** for the devotional service **Stations of the Cross -**

On the path of Ecological Conversion.
