



It is hoped that Henri's honest commitment to the spiritual journey will resonate deeply in the souls of the students, and that his writings will encourage them to search for and claim the unique themes of their own spiritual development. In this course, participants will:

- examine the scope and depth of Henri Nouwen's writing
- explore the ongoing struggle between Henri's own life and his desire for spiritual faithfulness
- reflect on the unique pattern of their spiritual path and deepen their walk of faith as a Beloved Child
- look at specific pieces of Henri's writings in a ministry context

There is one assignment at end of term. The assignment is reflective, asking the participants to integrate their reading in the required textbooks/course pack with their particular cultural and religious context.
