

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

I would like to congratulate all the First Communicants today. You have prepared yourself well for today. You are now able to share fully in the celebration each time the community comes together. I hope you remain mindful of what Jesus has done for you on the cross and that you grow in that same love in your dealings with all peoples. I look forward to seeing you receive the Lord Jesus' gift of himself often, so that he may strengthen you in his love.

This is a wonderful opportunity to remind everyone how to receive this most blessed of all the sacraments. The Church teaches: We come as those seeking communion, with hands held out as one receiving alms. Allow the minister to place the Blessed Sacrament in the palm of your hand (not as one who takes between your fingers). And with the hand placed underneath the hand that receives, to take the host and place it in one's mouth, all in full sight of the one who gave it to you.

For those who receive the Blessed Sacrament on the tongue, please open your mouth wide, stick out your tongue slightly and wait until the minister places it there. Any movement on your part complicates matters.

For those who receive from the chalice, please be mindful that others may want to receive from the chalice too. If you are suffering from a cold, fever or some other communicable disease, please refrain from receiving from the chalice.

I would also take this opportunity to thank Rory Fader, of our parish, for the generous contribution that allowed us to purchase the new hymnal that is now in your pews. Rory not only shares his gift of music with us, he has also provided for the songbooks that will serve this community for years to come.



Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

In 1967 the Bishops of Canada established the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace to foster justice and integral human development in the southern world. The Diocese of Nelson has been a strong supporter of Development and Peace through our annual Share Lent Campaign, numerous collections on the occasion of natural disasters and the Fall education initiatives. Our Diocesan and Parish Development and Peace Committees have been very active through the years and the Diocese strongly supports their work for justice.

Development and Peace fulfills its mandate in collaboration with more than one hundred partner agencies, contracting with them to carry out specific projects aimed at improving the lives of our sisters and brothers in the southern world. Recently, the Bishops of Canada have been informed that a number of these partner agencies have condoned and even at times advocated policies and practices which contradict Catholic teaching and, in particular, that they do not fully respect the sanctity of human life from conception to its natural end.

For this reason, the Diocese of Nelson, together with the other Dioceses of Western Canada, is temporarily withholding the 2018 Share Lent donations from Development and Peace. These funds are being withheld until such time as we receive clear assurance that its partner agencies comply with Catholic teaching and with the criteria set out by *Caritas Internationalis*, of which the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace is the Canadian representative.

I assure you that the funds designated for Development and Peace will only be used to assist people in need in the southern world.

It is important to recognize with sincere gratitude and admiration that there are many people throughout the Diocese of Nelson who generously and wholeheartedly support the good work of Development and Peace by their donations and by actively participating in our Diocesan and Parish Development and Peace Committees in their work of education and their advocacy of initiatives of justice. The temporary withholding of funds is an action taken to ensure transparency and accountability in how monies are used. It does not lessen in any way our commitment to the vision embraced by the Church in Canada in establishing the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace.

I write to you with the full knowledge and support of Bishop Bittman.
