PASTOR'S MESSAGE

St. Charles Garnier Parish realizes that the call to solidarity with those in need not only lies at the root of God's Call to each person, but also in the way he calls us as a community of faith. Having benefited from the generosity of some unexpected bequests, we would like to share some of that money with four of the more pressing needs in our community.

In the next few weeks, we would like to highlight four community initiatives, spearheaded by the work of Christians working together in our community. In doing so, we would like to support the work of those who give themselves tirelessly in Christian service to these initiatives, we would like to encourage our parishioners to consider donating to the work of these organizations in a substantial and ongoing way, and we would like to promote the work of Christian Outreach in these and other ways.

Each week we will highlight one of the four organizations and introduce their work and need to you. They will have an opportunity to promote their work in our foyer, be present to answer any of your questions, and set up a temporary display in our hall for weeks to come.

The first such organization is "Okanagan Pro-Life". St. Charles Garnier Parish will contribute \$3,500 to Okanagan Pro-Life for half the cost of a portable fetal heart monitor to be donated to the Kelowna General Hospital. In donating to Okanagan Pro-Life in this way, we support their work to promote maternal health and the sacredness of the human person in the womb. By contributing half the funds we are encouraging our parishioners to make up the difference.




