#### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Sisters and Brothers in the Lord,

The Passion of Christ is in obedience to Divine Plan, explains Paul in the letter to Philippians (2:6 -11) The Son of God who is also the Servant of God is sent into the world to Teach by example. Isaiah 40:1-4 & 49:1-6 narrates how the Servant would be challenged and undergo servitude despite his Trust in the Almighty. He would be discouraged, dejected, embarrassed and forsaken. But he should not give up, but hold on to God's Commission.

I was reflecting this 'Commission of God' in the light of the gospel of Mathew 26:50 wherein it is read about Judas, "My friend, do what you are here for' meaning 'do the business for which you are here for'. Then Judas kissed Jesus saying, "Greetings Rabbi". Jesus did not resist his betrayal even though his disciples offered resistance. Jesus resigned to the Divine Plan of God in order that we might be saved.

Shakespeare, the English playwright in his Julius Caesar wrote about the betrayal by Caesar's close and trusted friend Brutes. "Et Tu Brute" (You too Brutus) The Roman history of 15th March 44 B.C recorded this famous, thought-provoking phrase. Caesar was shocked to see his close and trusted friend instead of protecting Caesar was resorting to treachery. Caesar had 23 stabs but did not resist. He was resigned to his fate. Pilate had Jesus scourged (Jn19:1) and according to the Jewish law, the condemned person should receive 40 laces minus one. So Jesus had this most excruciating torture of 39 laces, but resigned to the Divine Will.
