

SAFE ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Dear Pastors, Sisters and Parishioners:

Bishop John Corriveau put into effect the new Safe Environment Policy on January 3, 2013 in the Diocese of Nelson. The second version of the policy is thorough, professional, and clearly explains procedures. After reviewing the Policy, the insurance company representative said, "It is one of the best guidelines I have seen so far...I am impressed."

As Church, we are the Body of Christ and it is our responsibility to care for each part of the Body: "As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ...so that there may be no division in the body, but that the parts may have the same concern for one another. If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy. Now you are Christ's body, and individually parts of it." (1 Cor 12:12,25-27).

The purpose of the Safe Environment Policy is to eliminate abuse and harassment in the Diocese of Nelson. The Policy strives to protect children, youth and vulnerable adults in the Diocese and to protect those who minister to vulnerable persons.

At the beginning of March, training was provided for the Safe Environment Coordinators for the parishes, schools and ministries. The coordinators will be responsible, along with the pastors and principals, for implementing the Policy at the parishes and schools.

We encourage all volunteers and employees to read the new policy. If you have a current criminal record check on file, it remains valid until it is five years old, at which time it will need to be renewed.


