SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY ST. CHARLES GARNIER CONFERENCE

An overview of our operations in 2016.

On behalf of the members of the Society I wish to report to you on the work we have under-taken over the past year in order to bring comfort and assistance to many of the less fortunate members of our community living in our Parish area.

What we have been able to accomplish this past year is in no small way the consequence of your generosity, both in the financial contribution you have made to our Order, and the manpower that has been expended in bringing assistance to the needy.

Your donations to our work has resulted in the following:

- We visited and left food and food vouchers at 151 homes, with second visits at some, for an overall total of 312 visits, 95 children were the beneficiaries of our visits.
- We participated in the "chew on this" campaign to lobby the Federal Government to combat poverty in Canada.
- We gave 50 Christmas hampers to families in our area.

Over and above all of this we provide financial support to Ozanam House, a house for recovering addicts.

We also provided hampers of food to the "Inn From the Cold" organization over the winter period.

We gave assistance to 180 adults and 20 children for rent, utilities, bus tickets, winter shelter, and much more.

And our resident market gardener grew 5600 lbs of various vegetables for the food bank, and for inclusion in our gift hampers.

Many others benefited from the fact that you the Parishioners of St. Charles Garnier provided the financial help that is so desperately needed.




