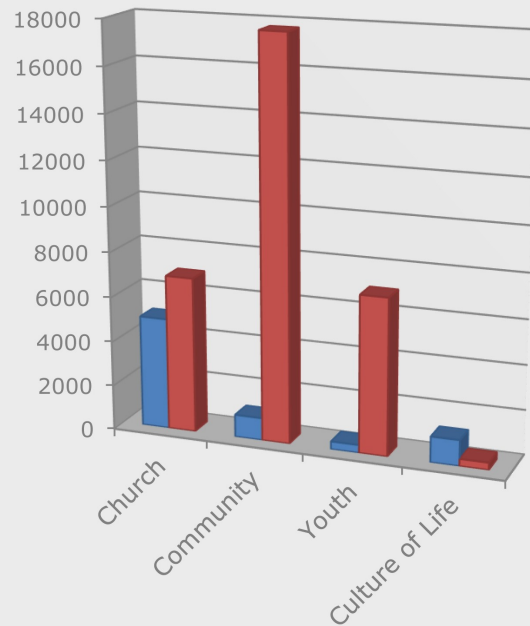

Dollar Contributions by %

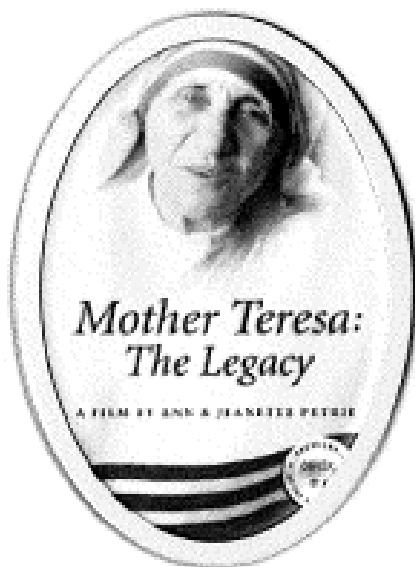
