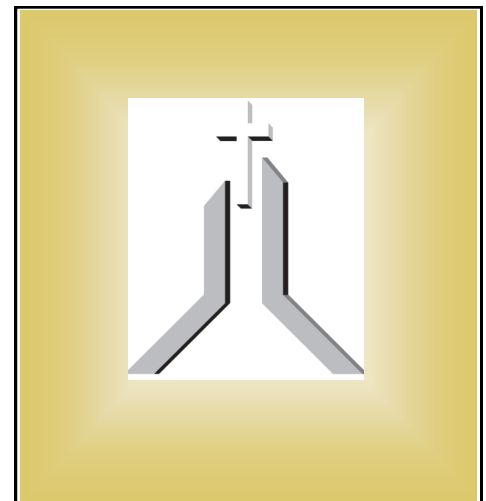

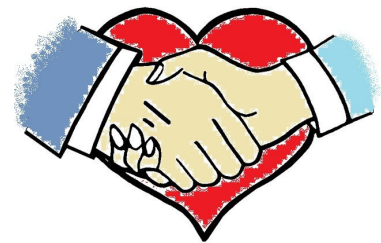


NEW PARISHIONERS

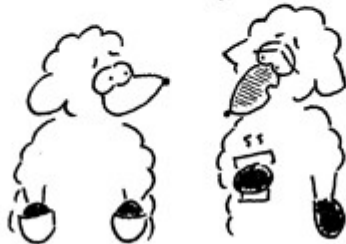
