Letter from Fr. Gord Walker

ORSINI HOUSE 95 St. Joseph Street Toronto, ON M5S 2R9

July 21, 2011

Dear Friends,

Thank you all for your beautiful card and your prayers and wishes for me.

Life here in downtown T.O. is at least similar to one of those old black and white films where people are racing in no particular direction looking for the hidden treasure – much different from the friendly city I left about 30 yrs. ago. The main sounds here are car horns, then fire sirens, then police sirens, but the nights are strangely quiet, usually. Bicycles, not cars are most problematic for pedestrians, and even pedestrians are often demanding their one foot of sidewalk space. There are some advantages – subway system and buses are very good and street cars still run on some routes.

There are 12 retired priests on this 3^{rd} floor -4^{th} floor is the infirmary and most of those 15 or so men need medication for various illnesses. We on the 3^{rd} floor have no particular job to perform, apart from taking a turn celebrating Mass and giving a homily. Our rooms are "en-suite" – a great change from seminary days in this same building.

There is much building of high rises going on – another noise that is prevalent. This leads to some detours for motorists. For me, the best part is the daily walks, looking through some of the large department stores which have no end of coffee and whatever shops – also there are 2 Tim Horton's, both about 2 blocks from here.

The annual "Walker Picnic" was a great success – about 28 attended and there were 2 new babies born over the year.

St. Basil's church and the College are across the street, and the student union is next door where a member (like me) can borrow one of the thousands of books and drink coffee and goodies all day if desired.

Surprisingly all my "stuff" arrived from the west – about 10 boxes of varied books, albums, clothes and golf clubs. I have not played golf yet, but my fellow priest (Fr. Neil Hibbard - we were ordained together in 1969) is a golfer and we have a tentative plan to play.

A niece and her husband live in Richmond Hill which is situated at the end of the subway line north plus a bus ride – they would pick me up there when I go. My sister Edith and husband can be reached by subway west and a pick up when I go.

T.O. was extremely hot yesterday (Thursday) - happily, our rooms are air-conditioned.
