The family lives in an area where there is a scarcity of water, and the soil is infertile for cultivation. Khushim is attending Balwadi Nursery School. His favourite pastime is playing with his little friends.

By ensuring that children have access to basic education they hope to lower drop-out rates and encourage self sufficiency. 
