The family lives in an area where there is a scarcity of water, and the soil is infertile for cultivation. Khushim is attending Balwadi Nursery School. His favourite pastime is playing with his little friends.

The Diocesan Social Service Society (DSSS) reaches out to poor tribal communities in the hill districts of the state of Manipur, India. By ensuring that children have access to basic education they hope to lower drop-out rates and encourage self sufficiency. 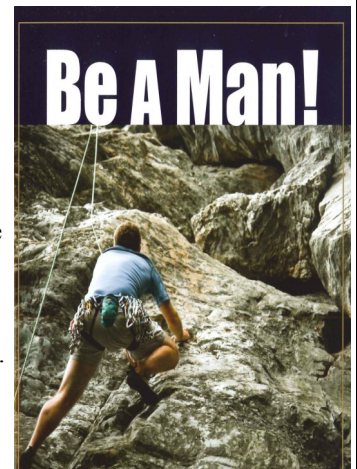

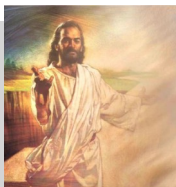

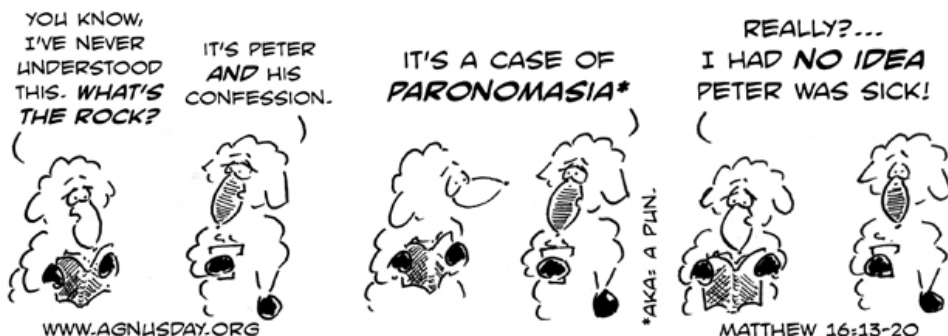
