Every volunteer needs a Police background check and they need to be trained in the art of managing our relationships in a modern world so that every person, including the volunteer, is safe as we all attempt to build up God's kingdom here at St. Charles Garnier Parish. The position is important but it is not time consuming. Most volunteers have already been successfully processed. Marilee, our office manager, is well versed in the Protocol and can explain the responsibilities of the Safe Environment Coordinator for anyone who would like to know more about this important position.


