



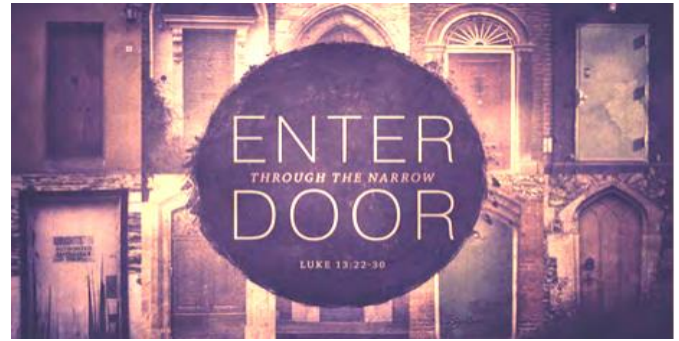

### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

I hope you are having a wonderful Summer and I pray that you will be able to enjoy it for a few more weeks. I do, however, want to update you on some of the things that will be happening in the coming months, so that you may mark your calendars accordingly.

As part of our month-long celebration of Seasons of Creation, growing in our awareness of our place on this planet, St. Charles Garnier Parish will be hosting a Hike-and-Mass for all our families, young adults, and parishioners on Sunday, September 15th. We will meet at the Scenic Canyon parking lot at the end of Field Rd. (a left hand turn off McCulloch Rd) at 1:30 pm. and hike down to Mission Creek (approx. 2Km). There we will gather for Sunday Mass. People are welcome to bring lawn chairs, but the ground cover near the creek is very conducive to sit on.

Beginning of Sept 16th Family Nights will be held every second week on Monday evening at 5:30 pm. This change, from Wednesday night to Monday night, will mean that Monday nights will alternate between Family Nights and Movie Nights. For those who would like to mark their calendars, Family Nights will take place on Sept. 16 & 30, Oct. 21, Nov. 4 & 18 and Dec. 2. At this point, we not sure about Dec. 16.

With Family Nights and Movie Nights on Monday, our Holy Hour for Vocations will be held on Monday for the last time on Sept. 9 (from 6:30-7:30 pm). Beginning in October, it will find its new time on the First Wednesday of each month at 6:30-7:30 pm. (Oct. 2) We hope that all our parishioners will take time to pray "The Lord of the Harvest" to send labourers into his harvest for the benefit of the people of God.

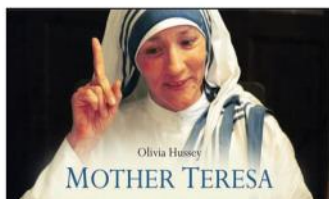

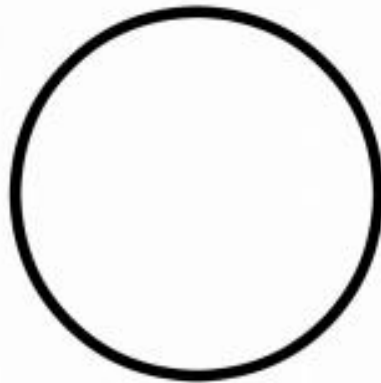

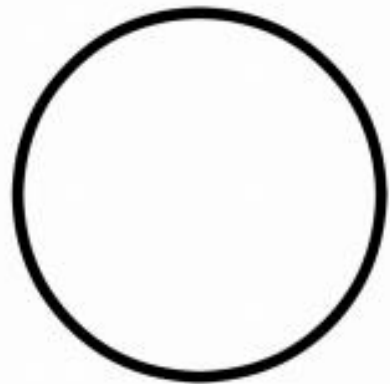
