We have requested a Catholic Syrian refugee family who we are sponsoring privately.

St. Pius X is sponsoring the wife's sister and mother. It will likely be at least a year before the paperwork is completed by the Canadian government.

In the meantime we have decided to enter into a joint sponsorship with the government to bring a family at risk from Colombia. They should be arriving within 4-6 weeks. Their names are Franklin, Maribel and a 3 year-old daughter named Mellany. He owned a furniture store in Colombia. We will keep you posted as to our progress and plans to welcome them into our community.
