
Christmas Prayer ^{for} Your Family

have often felt that no one cares. All gifts to be returned by Dec. 21, please.



Bishop-Elect Bart van Roijen's Installation as Bishop of Corner Brook and Labrador

The Holy Father, Pope Francis, appointed Fr. Bart van Roijen as the 11th Bishop of Corner Brook and Labrador! Bishop-elect van Roijen will be ordained to the episcopate on December 12th, 2019, at the Cathedral of the Most Holy Redeemer and Immaculate Conception in Corner Brook, NL.

Due to technical obstacles, the installation cannot be livestreamed here in Kelowna. However, a recording of the event will arrive, hopefully, by Dec. 14, 2019. If all goes well, a date for viewing has been set for **Monday, December 16, 6:30 pm** in St. Charles Garnier Church. Confirmation of the date and time will be announced from the altar, and if there is interest, a possible second viewing will be scheduled.


