PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Brothers & Sisters of St. Charles Garnier Parish, Greetings of Peace in the Presence of the Lord Jesus!

Ash Wednesday 26th February 2020 will be celebrated in our parish with 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM Church Services. This is a Sacred Season of Grace inviting us to have a house cleaning (Polishing our Conscience as encouraged in 1 Pt 1:13 "free your minds then of encumbrances, control them...")

The season of Lent is spread out for about 40 days beginning from Ash Wednesday leading up to the Passion, Suffering, Death & Resurrection of Christ the Lord! The high point of our Celebration is the Easter Triduum, the most Holy Three Sacred Days...1. Holy Thursday 2. The Good Friday and 3. The Easter Vigil.

During these days Our Christian living is encouraged to give expression to:

a) Almsgiving b) Prayers & c) Fasting. The Church cautions us to practice these qualities of piety with genuine sensitivity and it should lead to honor God not for vain glory.

Sharing our Food with the hungry. Be generous with the less fortunate by comforting them with our generosity and goodwill especially showing kindness. Engage in personal and private prayer making amendments to our life. Since most of our people are seniors and have health conditions, we are encouraged to recognize our weakness before the throne of the Lord.

All able bodies are encouraged to practice 'fasting'. Abstinence is recommended for those 14 years and older. Fasting is obligatory for 18 up to 59 years of age.



2020 will mark the 30th anniversary of the Society of St Vincent de Paul at St Charles Garnier Parish. The other parishes in Kelowna established conferences around the same time.

The Society is a 'lay Catholic

organization whose mission is to live the gospel message by serving Christ in the poor with love, respect, justice and joy. As Vincentians we see Christ in anyone who suffers, come together as a family, have personal contact with the poor and help in all possible ways.' (National Council of Canada).

For 30 years our congregation has reached out to the poor of Kelowna, mostly by helping them with food, but also with emergency help with utility bills and furniture when they are having difficulty making ends meet. Last year 292 home visits were made serving 219 adults and 99 children. At present, we are 19 active and 7 auxiliary members. We meet every 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month at 9:00 in the church hall. The main focus of this meeting is to report on the previous two weeks of home visits which are carried out by pairs of Vincentians. We spend time organizing various activities in support of this mission and nurturing spirituality, solidarity and friendship. Please accept our invitation to drop in on a meeting anytime to check it out.

"A parishioner at St Charles recently wrote to Bishop Gregory on behalf of the parish Care of Creation Circle regarding possible diocesan action to implement Pope Francis' encyclical Laudato Si, which speaks to climate change and our responsibilities as church. 
WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE SICK


