

THE FACES OF HUMAN DIGNITY

DPA: Human dignity is the right to live on your own land

The Phnong indigenous community in the Cambodian village of Gati has long lived in insecurity. As an ethnic minority, Phnong community members have few rights, and live in fear of being pushed

off their land and losing their traditional way of life. They are concerned over land conflicts in the area and the arrival of a mining company that recently came and dug holes around the community, laying claim over land that has traditionally been used by resin tappers. More than ever, the need for legal recognition feels urgent for the community.

"When we get a legal identity certificate, we can be the legal owners of our land and we will no longer be afraid of losing it," said Mr. Khum Peak, the chairperson of the Phnong Indigenous Community in Gati village.

DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE partner, Development and Partnership in Action (DPA), is working with Phnong families in the village of Gati to help them apply for legal identity certificates, which will then facilitate the process of registering for communal land titling certificates. "When villagers here have legal identity certificates, they

are able to prove their ownership in the case of land encroachment and land conflict with mining companies," said Mr. Keo Krak, village chief of Gati.

It will also minimize existing problems, such as large-scale illegal land trading, village boundary conflicts and the migration of people from outside areas. In addition, it is reassurance that the Phnong community will have a better chance at preserving its rich cultural heritage as families can continue to pass down their customs and traditions to their children.

"With a legal identity certificate, I can legally transfer my land to my children," said Mr. Khum Peak, who has 2.5 hectares of land for farming and rice cultivation. With this certificate, he knows that his children will not have to live with the same injustices that he did.

FROM THE PASTOR

Our Season of Lent is meant to resemble Jesus' 40 days in the dessert. Now if you count the days of Lent from Ash Wednesday to Easter Sunday you get 47 days. Since we are already the People of the Resurrection, we do not include Sundays as being



days in Lent. They are supposed to be days of rest, even from the disciplines of Lent. Does that mean that Sundays in Lent are days of chocolate? That is up to you.


To help set the tone for our season of Lent, we have removed all the plants in the church and we have tucked away the Pascal or Easter Candle only to be seen again at a funeral or baptism. Also to help set the mood we have made some changes to the beginning and end of the mass. They will resemble the Good Friday service by entering and leaving in silence. You are asked to help us keep the silence by standing still and especially as we conclude the mass, waiting until the ministers get to the back of the church.

Sometimes the best use of a liturgical tool like music is to not use it, or not use it as much. Hopefully these changes will inspire us to celebrate the great feast of Easter with a renewed enthusiasm.

You may not like the changes but Lent is the season when we are meant to ask the question; "What would my life be like without God?" and if the changes help us to ask this question and value the liturgy of the mass more, then our goal will have been achieved. I and your Pastoral Team appreciate your patience and perseverance. Happy Lent.






