PALMS FOR ASHES

Traditionally palms from last year are removed from the home during the season of Lent. You can bring the palms to church and you will receive new blessed palms on Palm Sunday. The palms will be burnt and blessed and these ashes will be used for Ash Wednesday. If you cannot bring them to the church, or you don't remember to, you may burn them at home BUT the idea is that all old palms should be removed from your home before the Lenten Season begins.



By Mary Jo Leddy, Published by Orbis.

If a refugee showed up at your front door with nothing but their suitcase and their child—what would you do? Call the police? Send them somewhere else? Or would you open your door and invite them in? Well that's exactly what Mary Jo Leddy did... Mary Jo Leddy is a well-known Catholic writer and founder of Romero House in Toronto. Romero House is a house for refugees, and named after Archbishop Oscar Romero of El Salvador, who was martyred for his outspoken defense of the poor in his country. The book is appropriate reading for anyone, especially in the light of the focus of Women Against Poverty.

SAVE THOSE STAMPS

Did you know your used stamps could provide food, clothing and school supplies to needy children around the world?



Here's how it works—the stamps are sent off to the Redemptorist Mission Stamp Burse in Windsor ON, who sell them. The money then goes to Canadian Food for Children Mission Fund run by Dr. Andrew Simone, who sends the supplies to 3rd world countries through local missionaries. 
