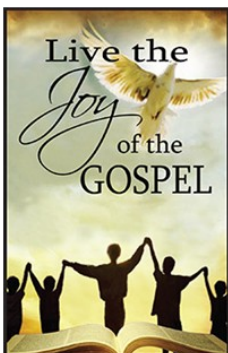
CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK FEB. 1-7
