2020 will mark the 30th anniversary of the Society of St Vincent de Paul at St Charles Garnier Parish. The other parishes in Kelowna established conferences around the same time.

The Society is a 'lay Catholic

organization whose mission is to live the gospel message by serving Christ in the poor with love, respect, justice and joy. As Vincentians we see Christ in anyone who suffers, come together as a family, have personal contact with the poor and help in all possible ways.' (National Council of Canada).

For 30 years our congregation has reached out to the poor of Kelowna, mostly by helping them with food, but also with emergency help with utility bills and furniture when they are having difficulty making ends meet. Last year 292 home visits were made serving 219 adults and 99 children. At present, we are 19 active and 7 auxiliary members. We meet every 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the month at 9:00 in the church hall. The main focus of this meeting is to report on the previous two weeks of home visits which are carried out by pairs of Vincentians. We spend time organizing various activities in support of this mission and nurturing spirituality, solidarity and friendship. Please accept our invitation to drop in on a meeting anytime to check it out.




