PILGRIMAGE OF FAITH



Purpose of the workshop:

To provide a *basic understanding* of the Pastoral Care that is provided to hospital patients, continuing care and assisted living residents, community shut-ins and members of our parish. This workshop will teach the basic skills needed for effective visiting. Our population here in Kelowna is aging and the need for good people to be willing to reach out with a compassionate hand is growing.

The workshop is open to all. It may be of interest in particular to: Parish visitors, Eucharistic Ministers, Clergy, Care givers, Church leaders, those interested in pastoral care and those interested in being more effective, caring visitors even if it is to your own family and friends.

The workshop will consist of six modules which are:

- 1. Introduction to Pastoral Care,
- 2. Theology of Pastoral Care, 3. Basic visiting skills,
- 4. Grief and loss, 5. Visiting the dying, and
- 6. Visiting older people.

There are four presenters who are all professionals in this field.
