SEXUAL ABUSE POLICY FOR NELSON DIOCESE

Our Diocesan Sexual Abuse Policy which has been in effect since 1990 has been updated with consequences for all those involved in Ministry to children, youth and vulnerable adults. All people who are involved in: **Religious Education, Children's Liturgy, Youth Ministry, Hospital Visitation, Ministry to Senior's Homes and Shut-ins**—will be required to meet the requirements of the new policy and be instructed in it. **Information meetings will be held Saturday, January 22, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. and Wednesday, January 26, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.** In the mean time people are requested to **pick up a copy of the policy** from the Parish Office and to have studied it prior to attending the meeting. Other parishioners who are interested in reading the policy will be able to do so at the Diocesan Website which will be launching with a new address soon. As criminal record checks are now required by all listed above, it would be good to apply for them as soon as possible. Reimbursement of the expense can be received from the Parish.
