The 2012-13 Appeal is continuing to progress well. To date 218 parishioners have contributed a total of \$91,401.00 for an average gift of \$419.27. This is





Annual Report for 2012

Client Visits:

During 2012 our members made 330 visits to clients in our area. Most of the visits were to distribute food hampers along with vouchers for fresh milk, meat and produce. When needed, we also gave out vouchers for clothing and bedding from the pro-life thrift shop. We have given out bus tickets and assisted with a wide variety of other requests. As well, we refer or provide information to clients regarding other community resources or services. We provided over 1000 volunteer hours during the past year.

Christmas Hampers:

This is one of our major activities! We distributed 85 hampers with food, vouchers, and gifts for each man, woman and child on the list. We were helped by many, many volunteers and want to thank each and everyone of you who helped in any way to make this possible. We thank the students of Immaculata Regional High School who donated money raised through their annual "Fast", the Corporate Sponsors and individual Parish Sponsors. In December we delivered an additional 15 emergency type food hampers bringing the total for December to 100 hampers.

Good News Bear Campaign:

We appreciate your generous donations made on our behalf to the Good News Bear Campaign on CHBC-TV. **Kids' Kapers:**

Through this program we were able to help children from families in need to take part in a sport or recreational activity such as soccer, art, gymnastics, swimming, etc.

Summer Camp:

Last year we were able to send a couple of children to camp at Camp Owaissi which is situated on the west side of Okanagan Lake. This is something that gives them an unforgettable summer experience.

Snowflake Tea:

In January we host a special afternoon tea at Sutherland Hills Rest Home. We provide a light lunch and entertainment and spend the afternoon visiting with the residents. They enjoy it very much. As well a couple of members visit every month to conduct Communion Services to the residents there.

Ozanam House:

We are very much involved with providing support for this special project which was developed through the co-operation of all the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul conferences of the Central Okanagan. Ozanam House is a transition house for men who are recovering from addictions and/or are at risk of homelessness.

Twinning in Peru:

Our conference is twinned with the Virgen Milagrosa Conference in Peru. We support them with our prayers and with a financial donation 4 times a year which assists them in their works of charity in Peru.

Inn from the Cold: We support them by providing their clients with fresh fruit and other groceries once a week. The Inn, which had it's humble beginning at St Charles Garnier parish, provides emergency overnight shelter during the cold winter months to people who are living on the street.

Vegetable Garden:

A few hardworking members planted and tended a vegetable garden again last summer. Despite competition from marmots, deer and gophers the harvest yielded over an amazing 6000 pounds of produce! This was donated to our clients and to the Kelowna Food Bank for distribution to all those in need who make use of the food bank.

We are so grateful to the many parishioners who support us in so many different ways. 
