# **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

At our last Parish Pastoral Council Meeting we discussed the various proposals we received in doing our part in meeting the needs of the poor in our community. We also discussed how we can be more transparent and accountable to you in regards to the parish's finances.

The two are linked. Regular financial updates (every three months) as well as end of the year financial statement and yearly budget (due out at the end of January) keep you informed and allow you to see the state of our financial affairs, including our reserves. This information will give each person the confidence of knowing that what is given in good faith is being managed in good faith.

Sound management of the money entrusted to us, no matter the source, should naturally extend itself in the parish's charitable works and charitable giving. Just as all Christians are called to give careful consideration to how they can help the plight of those in need, even more so the parish. Though it is prudent to have a healthy surplus, considering the physical assets we have, setting funds aside for specific and well thought out projects is also part of our Christian obligations.

In response to the proposals presented to us—and I thank all those who have submitted a proposal, I am truly edified by your care and involvement in the needs of our community—we would like to set up a sub-committee consisting of members from some of the major groups in our parish and ask them to study the submissions in detail and submit a recommendation to the Parish Pastoral Council. In addition to a member from the CWL, K of C and St. Vincent de Paul, we would be open to members of our parish who might be interested in sitting on this sub-committee, thereby including more people in the process, making it as transparent and accountable as possible. I would also welcome an Annual General Meeting discussing any final decisions in the context or our present financial position.

# **K OF C ANNUAL SERVICE BANQUET**


