

#### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

Next week, St. Charles Garnier Parish will be hosting a Ministries Fair after each of the weekend masses. Coffee and goodies will be available. At this time, I would like to thank all the groups and ministries who are preparing to take part in the Fair. Your work is greatly appreciated. I am also asking all our parishioners to please set some time aside to visit some, if not all, of the tables and to give prayerful consideration to the way you are involved and would like to be involved in the future.

In an unrelated matter, I would like to hear form anyone with hearing aids who is having a hard time understanding what is being said in the church. Even when a sound system works, not all people benefit equally. For some people with hearing aids, the distance between the source of the sound and the device can lead to significant distortion. If this is the case for you we want to hear from you.

New technology can allow us to bypass the sound system altogether and plug into one of the channels on your hearing device, speaking directly into your ear. Before making any decisions regarding the purchase of such a system, we first need to know how many people (if any) feel they might benefit from such a system. Some of our Public facilities (i.e. Kelowna City Council Chambers) are already equipped and may help in persuading or dissuading you. Please let our office know what you think by leaving your name and opinion.



# **GRIEF TO GRACE**

#### **About Grief to Grace**

Grief to Grace is a four to five day psychological and spiritual journey providing safety and support for anyone who has suffered degradation or violation through physical, emotional, or sexual abuse or neglect. It is appropriate for those who have endured rape, incest, or other forms or traumatic violation in childhood, adolescences, or as an adult. It is also suitable for those who have suffered abuse by a member of the clergy. This model of care provides therapy for the soul. The program is designed to help you experience the love and support of the suffering body of Christ as you journey through the Pascal mystery of your own life.

This effective healing process combines Living Scripture with journaling, group activity and discussion, therapeutic facilitation, cognitive restructuring and grief work. It is a pilgrimage to discover the love, tenderness, belonging, safety, joy and peace that are often missing from the stories of abuse victims.


