

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

January 20th—27th marks the **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.** This week is chosen because it revolves around the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul on January 25th. The feast is highly respected by all the mainline churches and reflects how the grace of God has a way of breaking through to our hardened hearts.

In the absence of a working ministerial and a formal prayer service shared between a number of congregations, I would still like to mark the week (and January 25th) with an hour of prayer for Christian Unity on Friday, January 25th at 7:00 pm. though the attendance might only be limited to our own parish—even though anyone is welcome, it sends a sign not only to the wider community, but also to God, that we truly long that His prayer may become ours, "that they may be one".

For some of you, this may come on relatively short notice. If you cannot make it, please offer some form of prayer or personal sacrifice for the Intention of greater healing among Christians. It is important that we do not grow satisfied with the status ouo, but that we place our prayers before God and be ready to back them up with greater charity towards our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Our hour of prayer for Christian Unity will take place on Friday, January 25th at 7:00 pm in the Church.

Our parish needs additional Sacristans. It's a "behind-the-scenes" ministry allowing for quiet service in the church, the duties are a devotional joy!







DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE



In the last decade, a growing number of people around the world have been forced to flee their homes and cannot return home. Today, 68.5 million people are living in forced displacement — an estimated one percent of the global population and the highest level in modern history. Violence, armed conflict, persecution based on religion or ethnicity, development megaprojects that destroy homes or livelihoods, extreme poverty, and environmental causes, including climate change, drive people from their homes and communities. The war in Syria has been a major factor of forced migration, but many other countries have become unsafe for some of their own citizens, including Burma (also called Myanmar), Afghanistan, South Sudan, Somalia, Sudan, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Central African Republic, Eritrea, Burundi, Iraq, Yemen and the Ukraine. Refugees, asylum seekers, and internally displaced people leave their homes because they fear for their lives, their freedom, and their security. These people need a safe haven, and Development and Peace-Caritas Canada works with organizations around the world to provide for the most urgent needs of those impacted by some of the worst forced migration crises in the world today. However, it is essential that we also address the root causes of this forced migration. Addressing these causes will require all of us to work together, from citizens to civil society organizations and humanitarian actors, to multi-lateral organizations to local governments.
