PASTOR'S MESSAGE

To commemorate Mary's apparition at Lourdes, and the many healings that have taken place there, February 11th has been set aside as the World Day of Prayer for the Sick. Special provisions are made by the Church to celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick on this day with all those who suffer with a serious illness (chronic or terminal) or are intimately united to the sufferings of Christ due to advanced years.

At our last Liturgy Meeting we had made plans to mark this day with the celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick at a Mass later in the morning. Since then, I have been asked to attend a meeting in Edmonton during this time and will not be able to follow through with this plan. Considering the importance of celebrating the Sacrament of the Sick at least once in the year, with the entire community present, I am moving this celebration to Friday, February 8th at 11:00 a.m. The 8:30 a.m. Mass will be cancelled so that all our energies may be directed towards the sick and elderly in our parish.

I ask you, the parishioners, to help promote this special celebration (Feb. 8th at 11:00 a.m.) within the community, especially among those who might benefit from the grace of God found in the Sacraments. I also urge the entire community to make an effort to attend, so that we may have a crowd of intercessors for those who are in need of God's healing grace. I would also like to remind those who are planning to receive the sacrament of the Sick (either now or at a later time) that the Sacrament of Reconciliation normally precedes the Sacrament of the Sick. That is why, in the case of someone dying, many people still refer to the three Sacraments (Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick and Eucharist), received together, as "the Last Rites" (notice the plural). I will be available for confessions on February 8th at 10:00 a.m.

Share the Journey

Canada the peacemaker: What role can we play in preventing forced migration? Canada can certainly play a larger role! Armed conflicts today are more complex, and civilians are often the main victims. Women play a vital role in conflict prevention and in building just, sustainable and inclusive peace. Peace pro-

cesses that include all key actors, including women and men from both armed forces and civil society have been shown to promote more sustainable peace. Canada's National Action Plan on Women, Peace and Security is a good start. However, if Canada continues to increase military spending while letting its international assistance budget stagnate, we will not promote a more peaceful world. To reduce conflict, Canada needs to ensure Canadian companies do not export arms to regimes where human rights are abused. When authoritarian regimes have access to arms, the impact of conflict increases, and gross human rights abuses can occur. Canada has traditionally played the role of peacekeeper in the world, and we must maintain this legacy in order to resolve existing conflicts and prevent future ones. Next weekend we'll be asking people to sign a card asking our Canadian Government to play a larger role in preventing forced migration.
