It has been suggested that the flowers in the sanctuary are not real and the arrangements are quite boring. First of all, boring is a very subjective judgment. What one person may consider boring, is for others the epitome of classic elegance. Second, the "floral décor" is not the main event and should not detract from the "the main thing" that brings us together - the celebration of the *EUCHARIST*. Finally, all the plants and flowers in the sanctuary are God's own creation - very real living breathing organisms chosen by our ministry for their amazing life giving, air purifying characteristics. A team of 6 women works diligently - each offering 1 hour a month, to maintain these beauties happy and healthy. We also have a generous group of parishioners who have donated most of these plants. Now, while any one of us humans can and will get sick due to airborne toxins such as benzene or formaldehyde - present in many glues used in carpeting and wood veneering, the beautiful Peace Lilies, the Ivy, and the Orchids in our sanctuary feed on those very chemicals thus making indoor air cleaner and easier to breathe. No dust, no mites, no mildew, no toxins. These amazing plants require very little light and not a lot of water. They do love being misted! In return, they bless us with the sublime beauty of their blooms and the gift of clean air. What a wonderful thing! Only God can create such wonders.
