PRAY WITH THE SAINTS OF CANADA FOR THE 150TH

Saint Marie of the Incarnation (1599-1672):

Saint Marie de l'Incarnation was born in France in 1599. She married when she was 17 years old, but her husband died two years later. Free to pursue her religious inclinations, Marie joined the Ursuline Order in 1633. Six years later, she boarded the Saint Joseph and journeyed to New France, where she was crucial to the spread of Catholicism. Marie and the other Ursuline nuns founded a girls' school which welcomed both settlers and Native Americans. They taught the basics of the faith, including Catechetics, prayers, and hymns. She died in 1672 and her feast day is April 30.

We pray: Dear Saint Marie, you helped build a welcoming place where everyone could find counsel as well as material help. You wrote, "Those worries never diverted my attention from God who was my constant preoccupation. On the contrary, I was strengthened because everything I did was in a spirit of charity and not for my personal profit." Intercede for us, so that all Canadian citizens may live more fully God's spirit of charity and let go of any material demands that divide us. Amen.
