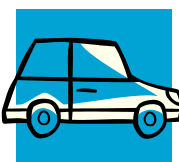

FROM THE PASTOR

Re: Landscaping

Most of our plants and shrubs are overgrown and need to be replaced. We also need as much lighting as we can get into the church, which is why we need to cut back much of the greenery on the Benvoulin side of the Church. The project will cost approximately \$20,000.00. If we collect the money and put it through as a Pilgrimage of Faith appeal project we will save 15% of the overall cost. We have a debt of almost \$250,000.00, which means that we cannot just go ahead with the project without a special appeal. If you would like this work to go forward, please clearly mark that your donation is for the landscaping and we will proceed when we have the money in hand. If you want to know more about the plan you can speak to me or Ed Rollheiser.



I also want you to know that we will be replacing the light bulbs in the church with what is called full spectrum light bulbs that are closer to natural sunlight. This will make it easier for us to read and sing. We will take the monies for this from general revenues.
