We encourage all Catholic people to participate in the following programs on July 7 and 8:



A very good friend suggested that we **pray the rosary** while working in Mary's Garden. What a beautiful gift to Mother Mary! Again, anyone is welcome to visit Mary's garden and pray the rosary while pulling out some "pesky" weeds. Bring your own tools. You may take the organic waste home to your own compost bin or you may dispose of it in the St. Vincent de Paul garden compost bin by Bishop John's house. Spend an hour with Mother Mary.
