PASTOR'S MESSAGE

I would like to acknowledge the excellent work done by Fr. Pat and Fr. Wayne and those who came before them. I hope to build on the foundations they laid in developing a strong Catholic presence and outreach in our community.

In order to build one must have a vision. A vision that is both clear and gives direction to who we are and what we do.

Pastors often come with a basic vision; a vision that takes flesh and blood as it is adapted to a new place and a new time. I, too, have a basic vision. I believe "a strong parish connects people to Christ, to others and to the community in which they live".

I also believe that many of these connections are best made in less formal settings and more flexible ways than in the past. The parish should be the hub and focal point of a variety of smaller groups that address the particular needs and interests of those who belong to them, with Christ at the center of it all.

I believe that small community groups meeting in people's homes, where people are most comfortable, focusing on some element of faith development, prayer, mutual support and Christian outreach (especially to neighbours and those in need) are worthy of our time and attention. Connecting people to Christ, to others and to the community begins by promoting meaningful connections. This is especially true for those who are new to this area or who have limited connections, even in the parish they have attended for years.

I look forward to my time at St. Charles Garnier and the portion of the road we will travel together.
