

Welcome all parishioners of St. Charles Garnier Parish,

Let us get ready for the Reopening of Our Parish Church for Liturgical Celebrations.

From the 6th of June 2020.

1.- Mass Timings:

Monday to Saturday 8:30 AM & 5:00 PM

Saturday Evening (Sunday Services 5:00 PM & 7:00 PM)

Sunday Services 8:30 AM, 10:30 AM & 7:00 PM

Dispensation from Sunday Mass: If you have ventured to attend a Sunday Mass and could not get a spot in the Church due to the Parish Registry system of 50 people only, "you have fulfilled the obligation by showing up. You are most welcome for the next available Mass. But if you are unable to come another time, your obligation is fulfilled". Go in Peace! Each Service will be only for 50 participants. If you do not get a spot, please try for another service. Don't linger around. Your Sunday obligation is fulfilled.

2.- Registration for Each & Every Mass is a Must for Contact Tracing Record according to B.C Govt. Regulations. From Monday the June 8th you can register in our webpage:

If you don't have access to a computer please phone the office 250-860-6776

Kindly notify with your Name and Telephone # for contacts.

Note that each person in a family will have to sign up individually to reserve a spot. For example, a family with two parents and two children will each have to complete the poll and enter the name individually so they can be counted individually.

Since space is limited, kindly avail, once a week attendance only for Mass and allow others also to have a chance to participate in the liturgy. Be generous, please! On entering the Church for your intended service check your registration at the desk and verify your particulars. If not registered, please register at the desk before entering the Church for service. Be polite and patient. Maintain Social distancing in and out of the Church 6 feet.

3.- Health Caution: If you have any slight symptoms of sickness, please refrain from attending Mass. When you are fully recovered you may return back to the service. Anyone who feels a health concern should remain in the house. 'Anyone having a Respiratory Symptom must remain home' informs the Bishop at this time.

- **4.-** Follow the sign protocols:
- a) Entrance & Exit Doors.
- b) Mass Timings Posters.
- c) Hand Washing symbols.
- d) Social Distancing. (2 meters)
- e) Sanitizing.
- f) Designated pews for seating for service participation.
- g) family seating with young children
- h) Washroom symbols.

5.- Entrance to the Church will be given only 30 minutes prior to the Service. So, come just before 30 mts. Do not wait outside the church in the cold.

Exit from the Church: When you have received Holy Communion, kindly leave the church through the Exit door. Do not congregate either in the church or out on the lawn or in the parking lot.

6.- Participation in the Liturgy: Please wear a non-medical mask and participate in the liturgical action & service. Mass is just for a shorter duration of 30 minutes only with limited singing with one Cantor or no singing at all. Short readings, a brief homily, few intercessory prayers, no collection or gift procession to the Altar etc.

NOTE: Please bring your own mask (non-medical) wear it and participate.

7.- Church Offerings & envelops can be dropped off in the basket near the entrance when you come into the Mass. No collection during the Service.

8.- No Vigil Lights at this time, they are removed as per the regulation by the Diocese of Nelson.

9.- Holy Communion only in the hand/on the palm of your hands will be placed gently by the priest. No communion will be placed in the tongue at this time. Kindly follow the social distancing protocol for the reception of Holy Communion, with reverence and piety.

**When you received Communion, kindly leave the church quietly to the nearest exit door.

10.- The Church is not to be used for any other purpose at this time except Liturgical Services & Church maintenance.

- 11.- Private Baptisms with Social distancing allowed with limited participants.
- **12.-** Reconciliation Services are possible with prior appointment.
- 13.- Funeral liturgy possible with limited numbers
- 14.- Marriage can be celebrated with limited participation.

15.- Sick call home visits are not allowed. Hospital visit only possible if the Hospital Chaplin invites (not when the family invites) B.C Health Dept. protocols

16.- Parish Office will be open on specific days. But you can leave a message with the Pastor at any time if you have a concern. I promise to return your call in a timely manner before I go to bed every night.
