### PASTOR'S MESSAGE

When the 7:00 pm Sunday Mass survey, came out many may have thought that it was the first step towards cancelling. Though cancelling it was one of the possibilities, it wasn't a foregone conclusion. Nor was it an attempt to lighten the pastoral load; there are parishes/clusters of parishes in our diocese that have more weekend masses. It was an attempt to hear from you.

Here's what we heard. Many of our parishioners rarely, if ever, attend this Mass. They were represented by 41 respondents. Understandable most of these respondents placed little purpose for this Mass. There are a variety of people, from our parish and from around the area, that occasionally attend this Mass. They were represented by 32 respondents. Most of them attend when they are otherwise busy with a variety of activities (including kids sports) or are returning to town after a weekend/week away. For some, it is the only Mass they can attend due to work commitments. One or two prefer it because it is the "quietest" Mass around.

There is a small group of people who attend regularly. They were represented by 9 respondents. Some of them simply preferring the timing, others have permanent work commitments, while others may have their own reasons. And, although some regulars are quite willing and able to attend other Masses, at no great inconvenience, others are not in that position.

We value your input because it raises awareness and appreciation of this Mass. Though some may dismissively call it "the last chance Mass", it may have a greater value than its sometimes sporadic attendance may reflect. In response, the Parish Pastoral Council has decided to support the 7:00 pm Mass as an integral part of our parish's mandate to its own parishioners and the wider area. Next week I will speak to the questions of ministries and the youth and young adult component of this same survey.




