PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Last week I gave a brief synopsis of the 7:00 pm Sunday Mass survey that was completed by 81 of our parishioners. In response, the Parish Council has expressed their support for this Mass. This week I want to address the question of ministries at this Mass and the youth and young adult response.

When it comes to the ministries at the 7:00 pm Sunday Mass, we will draw from those people who attend on any particular Sunday evening. We have had a number of people step forward and express a desire to help out when they are present. Please make yourself known prior to the Mass and let us know in what capacity you are willing to help out. If there are not enough ministers, an appeal will be made immediately preceding each Mass. In the case there are no Eucharistic Ministers, Communion from the cup will not be available. If anyone is willing to provide music, on a Mass to Mass basis, feel free to offer your assistance.

In regards to youth and young adults, the responses were mainly from a handful of parents and concerned parishioners, who expressed a need to revitalize this Mass, to reach out to the UBC-O community and to possibly hire a youth minister. From the youth that filled out the survey, they usually attend other Masses (mainly 10:30 am) and felt that more should be done during these Masses to reach out to them. This leads me to conclude that having a Mass dedicated to youth and young adults at 7:00 pm only makes if there is an active youth/young adult ministry at this time and we need to be careful not to segregate or limit the youth and young adults of our parish to just one option. This is, by no means, the final word and I welcome further discussion on this matter.

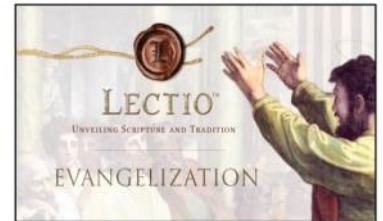

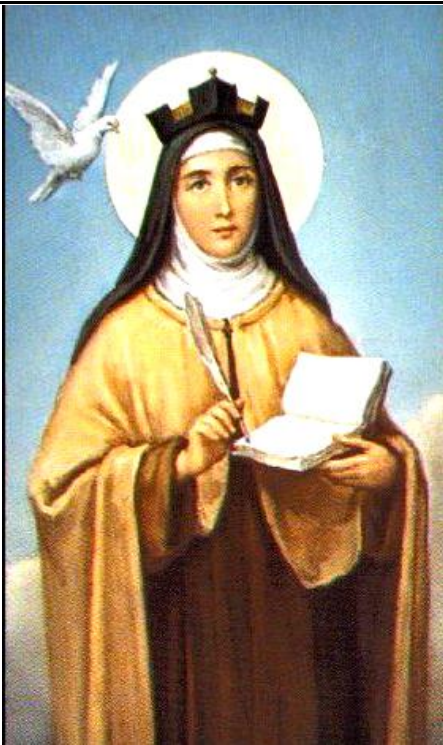
SETON HOUSE OF PRAYER FUNDRAISER
