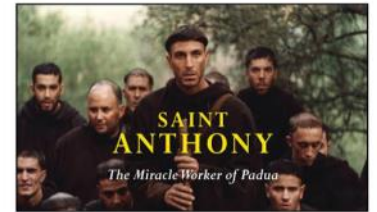

12TH ANNUAL OKANAGAN CATHOLIC FAMILY CAMP

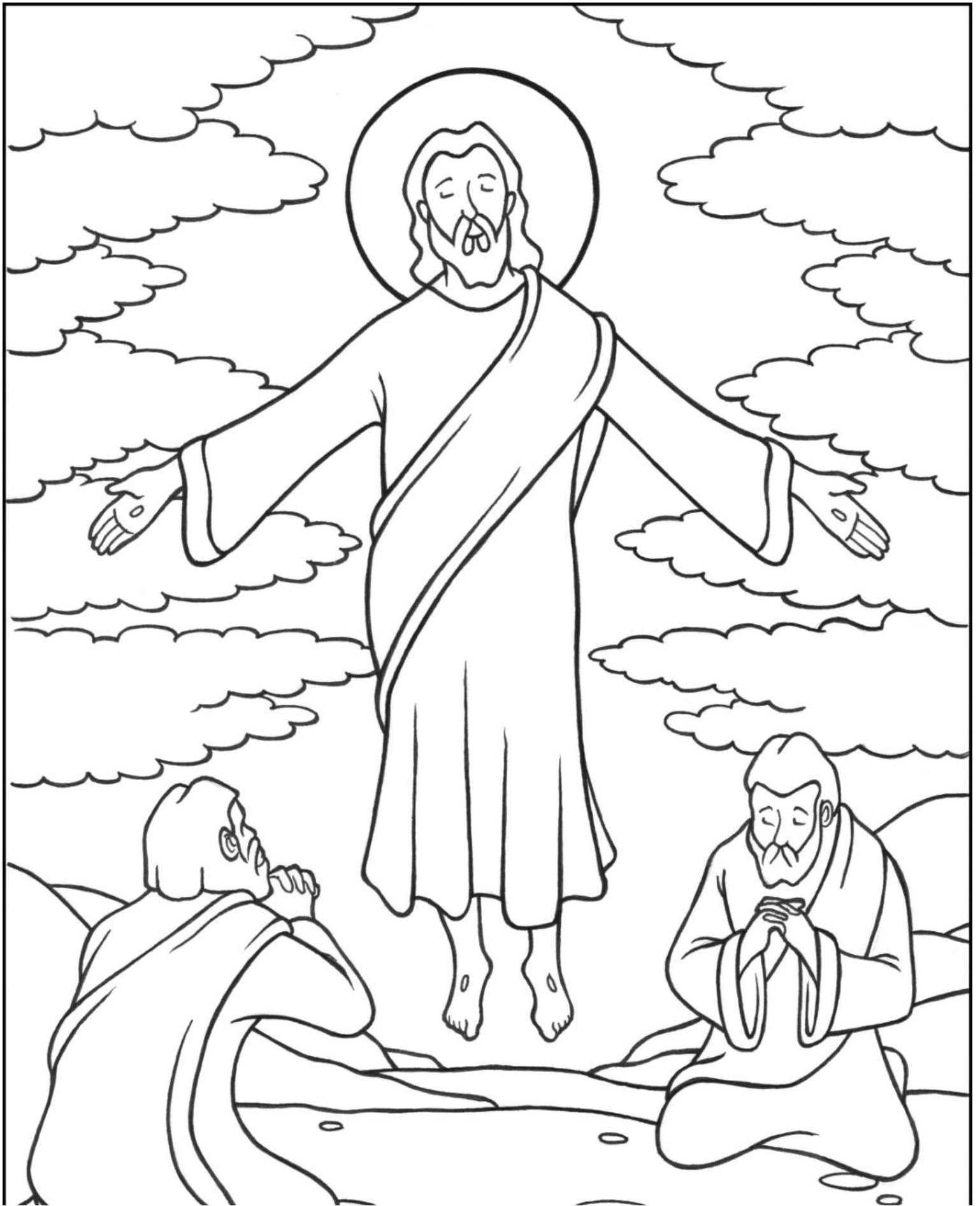
