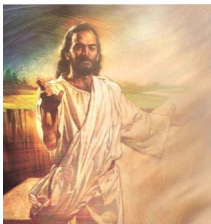
CWL RETREAT DATE CHANGE

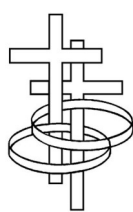
