#### **Dear Parishioners of St. Charles Garnier Parish,**

As you may know, I spent the month of May serving on a Catholic Christian Outreach mission to Ireland with 16 other Canadian young adults. It is with great joy and gratitude that I write this short letter of thanks to you, not only for your generous financial support, but encouragement and prayers as well.



We spent our first day in Ireland visiting the National Shrine of Our Lady of Knock, where a Marian apparition occurred in 1879. This helped 'set the tone' for the mission, and how much we would need to depend on Mary, Our Mother, while in Ireland. We then arrived in Galway, a university town on the west coast of Ireland. There we spent most of our time at the National University of Ireland – Galway (NUIG) attending daily mass and evangelization training, speaking with students about their faith, and hosting meet-and-greet events that included testimonies, talks, confession, worship music, and adoration! It was such an honour to be able to invest in the students that we met there, listening to their stories and their struggles in the faith. It was also an even greater honour to be able to encourage them on their faith journey, and to help equip them to be leaders in evangelization and the renewal of the world.



We then spent our last 2 weeks in Dublin, joined by 3 Irish students who wished to deepen their faith and develop their missionary hearts. While in Dublin, we helped facilitate a diocesan-wide Ecumenical Bible Week, 3 confirmation retreats for Grade 7 students, and 2 worship prayer nights. We were also able to spend time in prayer with Irish young adults in a pilgrimage to 7 churches throughout

Dublin, and a 14 km reflection walk along Howth Head trail. It was such a blessing to be able to pray with and for these faithful Irish young adults.

This mission was an incredible lesson about surrender for me. I heard a new seminarian share how we cannot receive all God wants to give us in life if we are 'grasping too tightly' to the things we think we want - whether that be a certain lifestyle, future schooling, relationships etc. He said that it eventually occurred to him that "our God is LOVE – why wouldn't I trust Him with my whole life?" This statement hit me like a wall, as surrendering control to God has always been difficult for me. But I truly felt my heart soften this mission, and a yearning to let Him be in control; to let go of the many things in my life that I have been clinging to instead of turning my eyes to Him.

This mission was also a powerful reminder of God's faithfulness. Many people have 'written Ireland off' as far as the Catholic faith is concerned. I heard one statistic of how mass attendance has dropped from 90% to 14% within the past 25 years; however, God is faithful. And we met His faithful – the faithful priests who continue to lead their parishes, the young adults who begin their own weekly prayer groups to help build fellowship and community; the young seminarians who wish to grow in holiness and love for Christ's church. There is hope, my friends, much hope – for God is faithful, even in the darkest of circumstances.

And so, thank you again for your willingness to support me and this mission in the renewal of

the world. The renewal that doesn't just have to start across the Atlantic in Ireland, but right here – in our families, our workplaces, our schools, our homes. Thank you for giving me this opportunity to serve and to grow deeper in love with Christ, so that I may show a deeper love for His people.
