world of justice. Their work bears fruit for millions of people in the Global South who are taking charge of their own destiny.





FASTING FROM FOOD

An Italian proverb says, "If you eat well, you will live well". Healthy eating is needed for a good life, but consider fasting for a solid spiritual experience.


Fasting is willing abstinence from all food and liquid except water for a period of time. The main objective is not for weight loss. Christ in the desert gave up food and drink in order to unite with Almighty God. Fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory in our religious practice.

Let us not put on a show or display of our fast. During our fast we express our sorrow and contrition. Fasting purifies our soul. We make peace with God and people. (Lev.16:19) Fasting unites people especially the rich and the poor. (Is .49:6) In fasting the rich share the condition of the poor who are often times hungry and without food. Therefore 'Share your bread" says Isaiah 58:6. Fasting helps us to practice charity. Fasting also promotes the attitude of sharing and makes us think of God's generosity to everyone. (2 Cor. 9)
