Dearly Beloved Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Charles Dickens reminds me of the suffering of the World in his novel "Hard Times" succinctly "Every day is a Good Friday. I long for Easter Sunday which never comes in my life". For most of the Citizens in the World, today severely affected by Covid-19 seems to be the same experience felt by the novelist of the Industrial Revolution in England.

As we near the Good Friday Services of Jesus Christ our Lord and Redeemer, we are reminded of His sacrificial self-offering of himself for our union with God. 




